1. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO ASSIGN THE US ARMY AS LEAD
AGENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF JOINT PUB 3-07.7, "JOINT TACTICS,
TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES (JTTP) FOR DOMESTIC SUPPORT OPERATIONS."
THE ARMY WAR COLLEGE PEACEKEEPING INSTITUTE IS DESIGNATED AS A
TECHNICAL REVIEW AUTHORITY. THE JOINT STAFF J-7 IS ASSIGNED AS THE
JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR (JSDS).

2. BACKGROUND. THE OCTOBER 1993 JOINT DOCTRINE WORKING PARTY AGREED
TO DEVELOP SEPARATE JOINT DOCTRINE FOR FOREIGN HUMANITARIAN
ASSISTANCE AND DOMESTIC SUPPORT OPERATIONS. RECENT DOMESTIC SUPPORT

OPERATIONS SUCH AS RELIEF IN THE AFTERMATH OF HURRICANES ANDREW AND INIKI, SUPPORT TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES DURING THE LOS ANGELES RIOTS, MIDWESTERN FLOOD RELIEF EFFORTS, AND FOREST FIRE FIGHTING IN THE WESTERN STATES HAVE EMPHASIZED THE NEED FOR A SINGLE SOURCE JOINT PUBLICATION WHICH OUTLINES CRITICAL INFORMATION AND JTTP FOR THESE OPERATIONS.

3. SCOPE. THIS JTTP SHOULD PROVIDE UNCLASSIFIED GUIDANCE TO INTEGRATE AND IMPLEMENT EXISTING POLICY AND DOCTRINE CONCERNING DOMESTIC (TERRITORIES AND POSSESSIONS OF THE UNITED STATES) SUPPORT TO CIVIL AUTHORITIES. IT WILL SET FORTH THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES AND CONCEPTS FOR ACCOMPLISHING SUCH OPERATIONS AND THE RELATIONSHIP DOD WILL HAVE WITH THE APPLICABLE CIVIL AGENCIES. AS A MINIMUM THIS PUBLICATION IS TO ADDRESS:

- A. THE CONCEPTS AND PRINCIPLES OF DOMESTIC SUPPORT OPERATIONS TO INCLUDE THE DEFINITION OF DOMESTIC AS A POINT OF CLARITY.
- B. THE DIFFERENT CATEGORIES OF DOMESTIC SUPPORT OPERATIONS INCLUDING DISASTER AND EMERGENCY RELIEF, ENVIRONMENTAL ASSISTANCE, MILITARY SUPPORT TO CIVIL AUTHORITIES, AID TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, AND UNDER WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES DOD WILL PROVIDE SUCH ASSISTANCE.

THE RECOMMENDED TARGET AUDIENCE INCLUDES THE JOINT STAFF, THE COMBATANT COMMANDER, SUBUNIFIED COMMANDER, THE JOINT TASK FORCE COMMANDER, THE FUNCTIONAL COMPONENT COMMANDER, THE SERVICE COMPONENT COMMANDER, SERVICE FORCES COMMANDERS, AND THEIR STAFFS FOR PLANNING AND EXECUTING DOMESTIC SUPPORT OPERATIONS.
