1. PURPOSE: THIS MESSAGE ASSIGNS THE DIRECTOR FOR MANPOWER AND PERSONNEL (J-1) AS THE LEAD AGENT AND JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR FOR THE REVISION OF JOINT PUBLICATION JP 1-0, DOCTRINE FOR PERSONNEL SUPPORT TO JOINT OPERATIONS. JP 1-0 WILL BE REVISED IAW THE GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED IN REF A.

2. BACKGROUND: JP 1-0 WAS ASSESSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH REF A. BASED UPON AN IN-DEPTH INTERIM ANALYSIS COMPLETED 27 OCT 2000 BY THE USJFCOM JWFC. THE JOINT STAFF J7 DETERMINED THAT AN "EARLY" FORMAL ASSESSMENT WOULD NOT BE CONDUCTED. JP 1-0 IS NOW IN THE WINDOW FOR A NORMAL REVISION.

3. SCOPE: JP 1-0 IS A KEYSTONE DOCUMENT WITHIN THE JOINT DOCTRINE PUBLICATION SYSTEM. IT ESTABLISHES THE FRAMEWORK FOR A HIERARCHY OF SUBORDINATE PUBLICATIONS THAT PROVIDE AMPLIFYING GUIDANCE REGARDING JOINT PERSONNEL PLANNING, POLICY, AND PROCEDURES. THIS PUBLICATION PROVIDES FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES, DOCTRINE, PROCESSES, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES FOR PERSONNEL SUPPORT OF JOINT AND MULTINATIONAL OPERATIONS.

ALSO, USJFCOM JOINT WARFIGHTING CENTER READ-AHEAD PACKET WITH THE CRITICAL AND MAJOR COMMENTS MATRIX ON JP 1-0 AS WELL AS LESSONS LEARNED FROM RECENT OPERATIONS AND EXERCISES SHOULD BE CONSIDERED.
