RMKS/1. PURPOSE: THIS MESSAGE ASSIGNS USJFCOM AS LEAD AGENT AND JOINT STAFF J-3 AS JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR FOR THE CONSOLIDATION-REVISION OF JP 3-01, JOINT DOCTRINE FOR COUNTERING AIR AND MISSILE THREATS. JP 3-01 WILL BE REVISED AND CONSOLIDATED WITH JP 3-01.2, JOINT DOCTRINE FOR OFFENSIVE OPERATIONS FOR COUNTERING AIR AND MISSILE THREATS (FINAL COORD 19 AUG 02), AND JP 3-01.3, JOINT DOCTRINE FOR DEFENSIVE OPERATIONS FOR COUNTERING AIR AND MISSILE THREATS (FINAL COORD 25 NOV 02), IN ACCORDANCE WITH GUIDELINES IN REF A. BOTH JP 3-01.4, JTTP FOR JOINT SUPPRESSION OF ENEMY AIR DEFENSES (J-SEAD), AND JP 3-01.5, DOCTRINE FOR THEATER MISSILE DEFENSE, WHICH WERE TO BE DELETED UPON APPROVAL OF JPS 3-01.2 AND 3-01.3, WILL BE DELETED UPON APPROVAL OF THE NEW CONSOLIDATED JP 3-01.

2. BACKGROUND: PER REF B DIRECTOR J-7 APPROVED THE JOINT DOCTRINE PUBLICATION CONSOLIDATION PLAN THAT INCLUDES CONSOLIDATION OF JPS 3-01.2 AND 3-01.3 INTO JP 3-01. A REQUEST FOR FEEDBACK (RFF) WAS RELEASED 15 JAN 03. USJFCOM JWFC ASSESSED THE UTILITY AND QUALITY OF THE SUBJECT PUBLICATIONS. FINDINGS OF THE JWFC ASSESSMENT REPORT REFLECT THE RESULTS OF AN IN-DEPTH ANALYSIS BASED ON DATA COLLECTED FROM NUMEROUS SOURCES, INCLUDING INPUTS FROM COMBATANT COMMANDS, SERVICES, AND THE JOINT STAFF. ADDITIONAL DATA WAS COLLECTED THROUGH INTERVIEWS WITH SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS, RESEARCH, AND REVIEWS OF THE JOINT AFTER-ACTION REPORTING SYSTEM, THE JOINT ELECTRONIC LIBRARY DATABASES, AND OTHER APPLICABLE DATABASES. REF C CONCURRED WITH THE ASSESSMENT AND CONFIRMED USJFCOM AS LEAD AGENT.

3. REVISED TITLE AND REVISED SCOPE:

A. PROPOSED TITLE: JP 3-01, COUNTERING AIR AND MISSILE THREATS

B. PROPOSED SCOPE: THIS PUBLICATION PROVIDES GUIDANCE FOR JOINT OFFENSIVE AND DEFENSIVE OPERATIONS TO COUNTER THEATER AIR AND MISSILE THREATS ACROSS THE RANGE OF MILITARY OPERATIONS.

 9. JP 1-02 TERMINOLOGY WILL BE USED TO THE GREATEST EXTENT POSSIBLE DURING THE DEVELOPMENT OF THIS PUBLICATION. NEW OR MODIFIED JP 1-02 TERMS SHOULD ONLY BE USED WHEN SUCH TERMS ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE PROPOSED DOCTRINE.
