SUBJ/PROGRAM DIRECTIVE FOR THE REVISION OF JP 3-07.5, JOINT TACTICS, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES FOR NONCOMBATANT EVACUATION OPERATIONS//

RMKS/1. PURPOSE: THIS MESSAGE ASSIGNS THE US MARINE CORPS AS THE LEAD AGENT (LA) FOR THE REVISION OF JP 3-07.5, JOINT TACTICS, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES FOR NONCOMBATANT EVACUATION OPERATIONS; AND THE DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS, J-3, AS THE JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR (JSDS). THE LA HAS ASSIGNED THE MARINE CORPS COMBAT DEVELOPMENT COMMAND (MCCDC) AS THE PRIMARY REVIEW AUTHORITY (PRA). PER PRIOR AGREEMENT WITH THE LA, USJFCOM JWFC WILL DEVELOP THE REVISION FIRST DRAFT UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE LA AND PRA. JP 3-07.5 WILL BE REVISED IAW THE GUIDELINES IN REF A AND BASED ON THE MATERIAL AND ASSESSMENTS OF JP 3-07.5.

2. BACKGROUND: JP 3-07.5 WAS APPROVED ON 30 SEP 97. USJFCOM JWFC COMPLETED AN INTERIM ASSESSMENT ON 30 SEP 99 THAT RECOMMENDED REVISION ON A NORMAL SCHEDULE. USJFCOM JWFC COMPLETED A FORMAL ASSESSMENT IN FEB 02 THAT RECOMMENDED VARIOUS CHANGES TO THE PUBLICATION. JP 3-07.5 IS NOW IN THE WINDOW FOR A NORMAL REVISION.

3. SCOPE: THIS PUBLICATION PROVIDES JOINT TACTICS, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES TO GUIDE COMBATANT COMMANDERS AND THEIR SUBORDINATE JOINT FORCE AND COMPONENT COMMANDERS IN PREPARING FOR AND CONDUCTING NONCOMBATANT EVACUATION OPERATIONS INCLUDING-SPECIFIC INFORMATION ON HOW FORCES MIGHT BE EMPLOYED.

THE JOINT ELECTRONIC LIBRARY ON-LINE SERVICES SHALL BE USED TO ENSURE THE LATEST APPROVED TERMINOLOGY IS USED.
