SUBJ/PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: REVISION OF JP 5-00.2, "JOINT TASK FORCE PLANNING GUIDANCE AND PROCEDURES" PRELIMINARY COORDINATION//RMKS/1. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO ASSIGN US JOINT FORCES COMMAND AS THE LEAD AGENT AND THE JOINT STAFF DIRECTOR FOR OPERATIONAL PLANS AND JOINT FORCE DEVELOPMENT (J-7) AS THE JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR FOR THE REVISION OF JP 5-00.2.

2. BACKGROUND. JP 5-00.2 IS WITHIN THE NORMAL 5-YEAR REVISION CYCLE. US JOINT FORCES COMMAND JOINT WARFIGHTING CENTER ASSESSED THE UTILITY AND QUALITY OF THE CURRENT JP 5-00.2. THE FINDINGS REFLECT THE RESULTS OF AN ANALYSIS BASED ON DATA COLLECTED FROM NUMEROUS SOURCES, TO INCLUDE INPUTS FROM COMBATANT COMMANDS, SERVICES, AND THE JOINT STAFF. ADDITIONAL DATA WAS COLLECTED THROUGH SUBJECT MATTER EXPERT INTERVIEWS AND A REVIEW OF THE JOINT AFTER-ACTION REPORTING SYSTEM AND JOINT ELECTRONIC LIBRARY DATABASES AND OTHER APPLICABLE DATABASES. ATTENDANCE AT EXERCICES TERMINAL FURY 04 AND AGILE RESPONSE 04 ALSO CONTRIBUTED TO THE ASSESSMENT OF JP 5-00.2.

3. SCOPE. THIS PUBLICATION PROVIDES FUNDAMENTAL GUIDANCE AND PROCEDURES FOR THE FORMATION AND EMPLOYMENT OF A JOINT TASK FORCE TO COMMAND AND CONTROL JOINT OPERATIONS THROUGHOUT THE RANGE OF MILITARY OPERATIONS.

A. JP 5-00.2 WILL ADDRESS THE FOLLOWING BROAD AREAS:

- (1) THE OPERATIONAL SETTING.
- (2) MATURING CONCEPTS, SUCH AS THE STANDING JOINT FORCE HEADQUARTERS AND EFFECTS-BASED OPERATIONS, WHICH ARE BEING FIELD TESTED AS PROTOTYPES.
- (3) LEAD NATION CONCEPT.
- (4) DISTRIBUTED AND SPLIT-BASED OPERATIONS.
- (5) INFORMATION MANAGEMENT.
- (6) HOMELAND SECURITY.

B. OTHER AREAS THAT ALSO WILL BE ADDRESSED IN JP 5-00.2 ARE THE ROLE OF THE HEADQUARTERS COMMANDANT, THE JOINT INTERAGENCY COORDINATION GROUP, COMPUTER NETWORK OPERATIONS AS THEY RELATE TO JOINT TASK FORCES, AND THE ROLE OF THE US NORTHERN COMMAND AS IT RELATES TO JOINT TASK FORCES.

C. GUIDANCE THAT IS REDUNDANT WITH OTHER JOINT PUBLICATIONS WILL BE REMOVED OR REDUCED.
