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Overview

Challenges:

- Resource disparity between Interagency (IA) partners and DoD
- Timely and purposeful integration with IA partners in support of complex operations
- Alignment of Training & Exercise (T&E) schedules with IA partners
- Early integration of IA partners goals/objectives with development of T&E concept development and scenarios

Way Ahead:

- Develop a process that allows IA partners to collaborate and influence early in T&E development
- Provide earlier and more opportunities to participate in shaping T&E
- Leverage virtual training systems to reduce cost and man-hour requirements to participate in T&E
- Continue to pursue additional funding to support IA partner participation in T&E

End State:

- Increase quality and level of IA partner and DoD participation in T&E programs
- Achieve IA partner and DoD intra and interdependent objectives
- Improve community approach to T&E achieved


- Provides 2yr projection of exercise participation requests
- IA partners invited to Worldwide Joint Training & Scheduling Conference (WJTSC)
- IA Partners invited to participate in T&E planning, at T&E venue
- DoD participates in/supports FSI & Other training programs
- Conduct T&E scheduling and collaboration conference in DC
 - Involve partners up front/throughout JELC
 - Opportunity to integrate partner needs and leverage DoD to T&E meet objectives
- DoD establishes a T&E community of interest portal

Provide/Conserve Resources:

- DoD LNOs provided to IA partners to facilitate integration efforts
- DoD assists w/pays for civilian travel/per diem costs for partners T&E participation when possible
- Explore adding LNOs/expanding roles to include Training Integration
- Continue to pursue additional funding
- Provide Joint Training Enterprise Network (JTEN) to IA partners
