<b>DISTRIBUTION A. Approved for public release: distribution unlimited.</b>						
<b>DISTRIBUTION B. Distribution authorized to U.S. Government Agencies (reason) (date of determination). Other request for this document shall be referred to (controlling DoD office).</b>						
<b>DISTRIBUTION C. Distribution authorized to U.S. Government Agencies and their contractors. (reason) (date of determination). Other request for this document shall be referred to (controlling DoD office).</b>						
<b>DISTRIBUTION D. Distribution authorized to Department of Defense and U.S. DoD contractors only (reason) (date of determination). Other request for this document shall be referred to (controlling DoD office).</b>						
<b>DISTRIBUTION E. Distribution authorized to DoD components only (reason) (date of determination). Other request for this document shall be referred to (controlling DoD office).</b>

<b>Public Release.</b>	X					
<b>Administrative or Operational Use.</b> To protect technical or operational data or information from automatic dissemination under the international exchange program or by other means. This protection covers publications required solely for official use or strictly for administrative or operational purposes. This statement may be applied to manuals, pamphlets, technical orders, technical reports, and other publications containing valuable technical or operational data.		X	X	X	X	
<b>Contractor Performance Evaluation.</b> To protect information in management reviews, records of contractor performance evaluation, or other advisory documents evaluating programs of contractors.		X			X	X
<b>Critical Technology.</b> To protect information and technical data that advance current technology or describe new technology in an area of significant or potentially significant military application or that relate to a specific military deficiency of a potential adversary. Information of this type may be classified. When unclassified, technology is export controlled.		X	X	X	X	X
<b>Direct Military Support.</b> The document contains export-controlled technical data of such military significance that release for purposes other than direct support may jeopardize an important technological or operation US military advantage. Designation of such data is made by competent authority in accordance with DoD Directive 5230.25					X	X
<b>Export Controlled.</b> To protect information subject to the provisions of Reference (d). Distribution "X" is superseded by issuance of this Instruction. Subsequent dissemination of formerly Distribution X documents shall display Distribution Statement C, with export control as the reason and shall be marked as directed in paragraph 8.a of Enclosure 3, unless changed by the controlling DoD office. <b>Foreign Government Information.</b> To protect and limit distribution in accordance with the desires of the foreign government that furnished the technical information. Information of this type normally is classified at the CONFIDENTIAL level or higher in accordance with DoD 5200.1-R.		X	X	X	X	X
<b>Operations Security.</b> To protect information and technical data that may be observed by adversary intelligence systems and to determine what indicators hostile intelligence systems may obtain that could be interpreted or assembled to derive critical information in time to be useful to adversaries. <b>Premature Dissemination.</b> To protect patentable information on systems or processes in the developmental or concept stage from premature dissemination.		X			X	X
<b>Proprietary Information.</b> To protect information not owned by the U.S. Government and protected by a contractor's "limited rights" statement, or received with the understanding that it not be routinely transmitted outside the U.S. Government.		X			X	X
<b>Software Documentation.</b> Releasable only in accordance with the software license in subpart 227.72 of the DFARS.		X	X	X	X	X
<b>Test &amp; Evaluation.</b> To protect results of test and evaluation of commercial products or military hardware when such disclosure may cause unfair advantage or disadvantage to the manufacturer.		X			X	X
<b>Specific Authority.</b> To protect information not specifically included in the above reasons and discussions but which requires protection in accordance with valid documented authority such as Executive Orders, classification guidelines, DoD or DoD-component regulatory documents. When filling in the reason cite "Specific Authority (identification of valid documented authority)."		X	X	X	X	X
<b>Vulnerability Information.</b> To protect information and technical data that provides insight into vulnerabilities of U.S. critical infrastructure, including DoD warfighting capabilities vital to National Security that are otherwise not publicly available.		X	X	X	X	X

## Building Compliant Distribution Statements

DoD Instruction 5230.24 (<http://www.dtic.mil/whs/directives/corres/pdf/523024p.pdf>),

Enclosure 4: DISTRIBUTION STATEMENTS FOR USE ON TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS provides guidance for constructing and using DoD approved distribution statements and their accompanying reasons.

**Paragraph 1a.** Requires: “The wording of the distribution statements specified by this Instruction may **not** be modified to accommodate additional distribution, such as distribution to foreign governments. Such release is outside the scope of secondary DoD distribution.” Other markings may be also used.

**Paragraph 1b.** Shows the format: Distribution Statements B, C, D, and E are expressed in a **standard format** comprising **four components** presented in the **following order**:

1. Authorized Audience or **Who Can Access**
2. Reason for Control or **Why/Reason\***
3. **Date of Determination**
4. Controlling Office or **Releasing Authority**

\*More than one reason may apply and may be used in a distribution statement.

## Anatomy of a Distribution Statement



- Use listed distribution reasons **as written**
- Use **complete mailing address** for the **releasing authority** (including office symbols)

<sup>+</sup> For Export Controlled Information: Include “**Export Control**” as a reason
