Abstract

The Department of Defense, Washington Headquarters Services has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) to evaluate the effects of the proposed Air Force Memorial, to be located at the Naval Annex Site within the Pentagon Reservation in Arlington, Virginia. The EA was prepared in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, and the Council of Environmental Quality Regulations implementing NEPA, and addresses the potential impacts and mitigation measures associated with the proposed action. The proposed action, as mandated by Congress, is the establishment of an Air Force Memorial on three acres of the Naval Annex site to honor the men and women who have served in the US Air Force and its predecessors. The proposed action would require the demolition of Wing 8 of the Federal Office Building #2. The proposed Memorial would include three spires, ranging from approximately 200 feet to 270 feet in height, a parade ground, an honor guard sculpture, contemplative outdoor rooms and seating areas, pedestrian walkways, and a parking area.
