- Introduction of FIPT Members
 - Absent: MAJ Turbyfill, Mr. Sharkus, Mr. Ulrey, Ms. Gould, LTC Trigg
- S&T Manager Certification Requirements—Dr. Marty Falk
 - Proposed Level III Experience:
4 yrs of science and technology management experience or a combined 4 years of acquisition and science and technology related experience, which must include at least 2 years of science and technology management experience.
 - Proposed Level III prerequisite: CLM Technology Readiness Assessments
 - Rationale for above changes: Current level III experience requirement of only 2 years is less than the “norm” of 4 years and is no different than the level II requirement. Adding the CLM prerequisite will free up in class time for other topics.
 - **ACTION:** Review proposal and respond within 30 days regarding acceptance of proposal and when service will implement these changes.
- Update on STM 201—Dr. Jay Gould

- Questions: How do we make DAU aware of changing STM policies? DAU will strive for more face to face contact with S&T POCs. Ms Foster will provide DAU with “current news” updates. Is DAU getting S&T budget information from correct source? DAU will coordinate with Ms Foster.
