SUBJECT: Reporting Requirements for Retired Military Pay File Extracts (RMPFE)

References: See Enclosure 1

1. PURPOSE. In accordance with the authority in DoD Directive (DoDD) 5124.02 (Reference (a)), this Instruction reissues and renames DoD Instruction (DoDI) 7770.1 (Reference (b)) to establish policy, assign responsibilities, prescribe procedures, and establish requirements for the electronic transmission reporting of Military Retired (RT) and Military Retired Annuitant (RTA) pay files, maintained by the Military Services, to the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC).

2. APPLICABILITY

a. This Instruction applies to:

(1) OSD, the Military Departments (including the Coast Guard at all times, including when it is a Service in the Department of Homeland Security by agreement with that Department), the Office of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the Joint Staff, the Combatant Commands, the Office of Inspector General of the Department of Defense, the Defense Agencies, the DoD Field Activities, and all other organizational entities within the DoD (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "DoD Components").

(2) The Commissioned Corps of the Public Health Service and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, by agreement with the Departments of Health and Human Services and Commerce, for submission of uniformed service RT and RTA pay records.

(3) All retired uniformed service personnel, including enlisted members, warrant officers, and commissioned officers, as well as their survivors who are receiving or are eligible to receive retirement payments or annuities during each reporting period.

b. This Instruction does not apply to reservists who have completed the service required for a non-regular retirement but not yet attained the statutory age for receipt of retirement payments.

3. DEFINITIONS. See Glossary.

4. POLICY. It is DoD policy that:

a. The DoD shall maintain a centralized database for the timely reporting of RT and RTA military personnel pay data for interagency reporting, research, actuarial purposes, and evaluation of DoD programs and policies.

b. The requirements and procedures prescribed by DoD 5400.11-R (Reference (c)) and DoDD 5015.2 (Reference (d)) must be followed to safeguard the personnel data comprised of personally identifiable information in this database. Individuals having access to this database may be held personally responsible and punished for making unauthorized disclosures.

c. The database is subject to computer matching programs, as prescribed by Reference (c). Computer matching is conducted with other Federal and non-Federal agencies to verify eligibility for benefit programs and determine continued compliance with benefit program requirements. Matching is also conducted to recover improper payments made to or delinquent debts owed by Federal personnel to include current and former military members.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES. See Enclosure 2.

6. PROCEDURES. See Enclosure 3.

7. INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS

a. The reporting of retired military pay records referred to in Enclosure 4 of this Instruction is exempt from licensing with a report control symbol in accordance with paragraph C4.4.2. of DoD 8910.01-M (Reference (e)).


b. The reporting of military survivor pay records referred to in Enclosure 5 of this Instruction is exempt from licensing with a report control symbol in accordance with paragraph C4.4.2. of Reference (e).

8. RELEASABILITY. UNLIMITED. This Instruction is approved for public release and is available on the Internet from the DoD Issuances Website at <http://www.dtic.mil/whs/directives>.

9. EFFECTIVE DATE This Instruction:

a. Is effective February 8, 2013.

b. Must be reissued, cancelled, or certified current within 5 years of its publication in accordance with DoD Instruction 5025.01 (Reference (f)). If not, it will expire effective February 8, 2023 and be removed from the DoD Issuances Website.

ENCLOSURE 2

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. UNDER SECRETARY OF DEFENSE FOR PERSONNEL AND READINESS (USD(P&R)). The USD(P&R) shall provide policy guidance for reporting of RT and RTA military pay records within the DoD.

2. DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE HUMAN RESOURCES ACTIVITY (DoDHRA). The Director, DoDHRA, under the authority, direction, and control of the USD(P&R), shall ensure that the Director, DMDC:

a. Serves as custodian of automated extracts of military pay records and provides data quality control analysis and reporting, inquiry capabilities, and administrative and computer support.

b. Determines if uniform service reporting may be accomplished through secure electronic data transfer.

c. Establishes for electronic submissions an account number and password for reports and provides additional system specifications.

d. Develops, produces, and distributes all periodic and ad hoc RT and RTA reports.

e. Provides record-level data, programming, reports, and analytical support, as requested, to the USD(P&R) for special studies requiring use of the RT and RTA.

f. Reviews the DMDC submission requirements and report instructions provided in Enclosure 3 of this Instruction at least annually and develops changes, as required.

3. UNDER SECRETARY OF DEFENSE (COMPTROLLER)(USD(C))/CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER (CFO), DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. The USD(C)/CFO shall:

a. Establish DoD policy and provide information and compliance guidance for the administration of RT and RTA military pay.

b. Exercise authority, direction, and control over the Director, Defense Finance Accounting System (DFAS), in matters pertaining to the operations and functions of the DFAS in accordance with DoDD 5118.03 and Volume 7B of DoD 7000.14-R (References (g) and (h)).

4. SECRETARIES OF THE MILITARY DEPARTMENTS AND COMMANDANT, U.S. COAST GUARD (USCG). The Secretaries of the Military Departments and the Commandant, USCG, working with their respective pay sites, shall implement this Instruction.

5. THE COMMISSIONED CORPS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE AND THE NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION. The Commissioned Corps of the Public Health Service and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, by agreement with the Departments of Health and Human Services and Commerce working with their respective pay site, shall implement this Instruction.

ENCLOSURE 3

PROCEDURES

1. GENERAL GUIDANCE

a. This enclosure provides guidance to collect and report pay data pertaining to those data elements that are available on existing uniformed services as defined in Joint Publication 1-02 (Reference (i)), automated information processing systems.

b. Reporting shall follow the data field sequence in accordance with the Master File coding instructions specified in Enclosures 4 and 5 of this Instruction.

c. Each report shall be accompanied by an e-mail message that identifies the files transmitted and states the number of records in each file.

d. Use data elements standardized in accordance with Reference (e) and DoDD 8320.02 (Reference (j)). The pay sites failing to comply with the coding instructions in this Instruction shall be responsible for the conversion costs in accomplishing data interchange.

e. Each fiscal year contains 12 monthly reporting periods.

f. The first report under this Instruction shall be for the first full month following the effective date of implementation of this Instruction and shall be submitted by the 15th of the following month. Subsequent reports shall be submitted within 5 days of the close of the month reported.

2. DMDC SUBMISSION AND REPORT INSTRUCTIONS

a. Data Media. Data shall be submitted to the DMDC via secure electronic transmission in compliance with the data submission requirements of this Instruction.

b. Reporting Requirements

(1) Each pay site shall submit its data files by uniformed service within 5 calendar days of each month's end ("as-of" date of the file), except as noted in paragraph 1.f. of this enclosure.

(2) Each uniformed service file shall contain one record for each uniformed service member or uniformed service member annuitant who is on its RT or RTA payroll as of the reporting date.

c. Data Specifications

(1) Order each file by Person Social Security Number (SSN) Identifier (Record Field 2), in ascending order.

(2) Numeric data that are not dollar amounts shall be right-justified with leading zeroes.

(3) Alphabetical data shall be left-justified with trailing blanks.

(4) All dates shall be reported as YYYYMMDD unless otherwise instructed in the data element description.

(5) All dollar amount fields such as pay and premium amounts shall be signed dollars and cents, with implied decimal, unless otherwise specified.

d. Electronic Secure Submission

(1) Data Submission. To electronically submit data to DMDC, the pay site shall contact DMDC's RT and RTA Pay File Manager, who shall ensure the establishment of an account number and password exclusively for these submissions and provide additional system specifications, including security protocols appropriate to protect the data from compromise and consistent with standards established by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (see <http://www.nist.gov/index.html>).

(2) Transmission of Sensitive Information. The confidentiality level of data being sent to DMDC, as specified in Enclosure 4 of this Instruction, is considered SENSITIVE in accordance with the guidance contained in DoDI 8500.2 (Reference (k)). Sensitive information may be sent via the SECRET Internet Protocol Router Network or Nonsecure Internet Protocol Router Network (NIPRNET). Sensitive information sent via the NIPRNET must be encrypted prior to transmission. The submitting organization is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of each electronic data transfer.

PART II. DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise noted, these terms and their definitions are for the purpose of this Instruction.

annuitant. A person receiving an annuity.

annuity. A monthly payment made to a person as a result of a specific survivorship plan.

basic pay. The active-duty pay rates prescribed for an officer or enlisted member according to pay grade and years of service.

cost of living allowance. Percentage change applied to retired pay and SBP annuities based on laws using the Consumer Price Index, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, to determine the amount of income.

CRDP. This program provides a 10-year phase-out (with certain exceptions) of the offset of military retired pay for retired members who receive VA disability compensation, have a combined VA disability rating of 50 percent or greater, and are active or Reserve members receiving retired pay for longevity or disability retirees with more than 20 years of service in accordance with section 1414 of Reference (1).

CRSC. This program provides a special monthly payment that is equivalent to the portion of military retired pay offset for receipt of VA disability compensation determined to be combat-related. Qualified individuals include any military retired members whose retired pay is offset

for VA compensation based on a combat-related disability in accordance with section 1413a of Reference (l).

CSB. A program provided by the 1986 Military Reform Act by which a member agrees to certain active service requirements in return for bonus pay in accordance with Reference (m).

DFAS. Utilizing the Defense Retiree and Annuitant System, provides services for Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Air Force retirees and their annuitants.

DIC. Compensation paid by the VA to the widow or widower of a member who dies after December 31, 1956, from a service connected or compensable disability in accordance with Reference (q).

DoDHRA. A DoD agency that supports the USD(P&R), providing program and policy support and information management and administrative services to the DoD Components on human resource matters. It collects, archives, and provides management information, research and analysis of human resources, and other related functional area databases for the DoD.

FR/FMCR. A Component of the Regular Service (Navy or Marine Corps) to which members may be transferred and released from active duty after obtaining 20 or more years of active Federal service.

pay grade. The step or degree in a graduated scale to which members of the uniformed services are assigned or distributed for military pay and allowances purposes.

pay sites. Those activities that provide finance and accounting services for Military retirees and their annuitants.

retired pay (includes FR and FMCR retainer pay). The gross entitlement for a member based on conditions of the retirement law, pay grade, years of service for basic pay, years of service for percentage multiplier, percentage of disability, if applicable, and date of retirement (transfer).

REDUX. The CSB/REDUX retirement system applies to those who entered Service on or after August 1, 1986, AND who elected to receive the \$30,000 CSB at their 15th year of service in accordance with Reference (m).

retirement date. The first day of entitlement to retired pay, not a day of active duty.

RSFPP. A survivor benefit program authorized by chapter 73, subchapter I, Reference (l).

SBP/RCSBP. A survivor benefit program authorized by chapter 73, subchapter II, Reference (l).

TERA. A temporary force management tool enacted to affect a drawdown of military forces. Authorized in accordance with the temporary early retirement provisions of section 12731a of Reference (l).

Tower Amendment. The law provided that a member retiring after January 1, 1971, may not receive less retired pay than the monthly retired or retainer pay to which he or she would be entitled if the member had become entitled to retired or retainer pay at an earlier date in accordance with section 1401a(f) of Reference (1).

uniformed services. Defined in Reference (i).
