- Comment types are CORRECTLY used (see Instructions for definitions of crucial and substantive comments)
- Conflicting comments from agencies within your Component are resolved
- Coordinator justification is provided
- POC information is complete and correct

DO NOT:

- Complete A/R/P field
- Complete Originator Justification for Resolution field

When compiling your consolidated SD 818, be sure that:

- Comments are in page / para # order and are as submitted by coordinating agency - DO NOT PARAPHRASE
- Classified text / comments are correctly marked
- A/R/P field is completed
- Originator justification is provided for rejected / partially accepted comments
- Comment types are CORRECTLY used (if AO feels that the coordinating agency has used "C" in error, contact the POC to resolve)
- Comments are critical or substantive; no administrative comments
- Critical comments have either been accepted, or rejected / partially accepted comments have been seen and approved by coordinating agency AND this is noted in the Originator Justification field
- Conflicting comments among coordinating agencies are resolved; Originator Justification field in relevant comments explains solution
